Scholarship Applicant Criteria: The applicant should ideally be...

- A Pinellas County full time resident <u>or</u> current member of the Friends of Pinellas Master Naturalists (member when application submitted and scholarship drawn)
- Volunteering or working in the environmental field or showing interest to learn more
- In a position to have a positive influence on others (spread the word of lessons learned)
- Have the ability to fully participate in the class (time off from work, etc.)

Ideally, the candidate will be in a position to share learned experiences with a great number of people, i.e. have a large sphere of influence on both youth and adult.

Two class scholarships are randomly awarded each year at the January and July board meetings – (the application due date for the scholarship awarded in July is June 30^{th} / the application due date for the scholarship awarded in January is December 31^{st}).

The scholarship is good for one of the seven Florida Master Naturalist Program courses and must be used for a course offered in Pinellas County before the end of one year from the award date.
